INTRODUCTION

Under part VII of the Mining Rules 1934, Rule 61, the Mines Department (presently known as Department of Minerals and Geoscience) came to a decision to issue "Shot-firers" competency letters before 1957 and also certificates since the early 1990s to individuals required for performing this specialised task in the mining sector. This competency letter and subsequently followed by the "shot-firers" were recognised by government departments as competency for carrying blasting work at mines, quarries and at construction sites. For the benefit of the industry, the certificates are also issued to individuals in the quarrying industry. These practices are also carried out in the States of Perak, Selangor, Pahang, Kelantan and Sabah where the Department of Minerals and Geoscience is the regulating authority over Quarry operations under the State Quarry Rules.

The Institute of Quarrying Malaysia with the co-operation of the Department of Minerals and Geoscience has also been regularly conducting Shot-firers Courses and subsequently candidates are encouraged to sit for the Shot-firers' examination conducted by the Department of Minerals and Geoscience. Those who pass the theoretical and practical examinations are issued with the Shot-firer's Certificate by the Department of Minerals and Geoscience. The examination is an official government examination and recognised by the Public Service Department and Department of Minerals and Geoscience as the competency certificate for shot firing.

The Shot-Firers Course is also accredited by the Board of Engineers Malaysia (BEM) under the Continuing Professional Development Programme (CPD) with an approved CPD of 40 hours.

E. Closing Date


The closing date for registration is 13 April 2007.

BENEFITS

1. The requirement of "shot-firer" is specially stated in the Mining Rules 1934 and States Quarry Rules where the Department of Minerals and Geoscience is the authority to issue such competent shot-firers' certificates on mining and quarry land under their jurisdiction. Personnel who do not possess the required level of competency are not allowed to carry out blasting or shot firing works in Malaysia.
2. Under Mining Rules 1934, Rule 61 (vii) requires the manager of mines to appoint "shot-firers". Only appointed "shot-firers" are allowed to charge a hole with any explosives or to fire any charge, or to even carry any explosives into a mine. No person under the age of twenty-one shall be allowed to be appointed to the position of "shot-firers".
3. A Shot-Firers' Certificate will be issued by the Department of Minerals and Geoscience to candidates who have passed the written and practical examinations. This Certificate is officially recognised throughout Malaysia.
4. Shot-firing or blasting is an essential part of quarrying or hard-rock mining and requires special knowledge and skills to achieve economic production costs while still maintaining safety and health as well as environmental quality.
5. Employers or quarry owners will be happier to engage someone who has undergone training recognised by the enforcement authority that he is competent in the handling of explosives and know safe blasting procedures.
6. The skills acquired by personnel through experience of working with explosives can only be assessed by making the personnel undergo a competency test.
7. The Shot-Firers' Course is approved under the Human Resource Development scheme.
